

A correct placing of your photos in the crop area is essential for composing and printing without *unwanted* white borders. Both with Photoshop (+ our template) and Epoca Software, images must be placed following some basic rules about crop guides. As you can see from the examples below, is important to align the photo border with the page border and to make sure that the subject is inside the lines.

The edge of your photos must **not** stay between crop guides and the edge of the page or exactly aligned with crop guides.

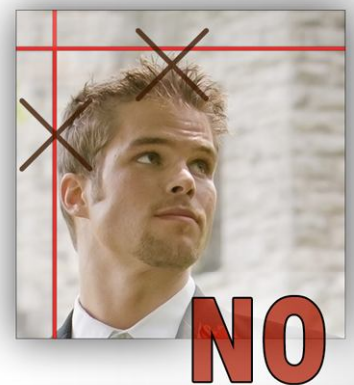


Photos must cover all the white space between crop guides and the edge of the page.

To avoid the cropping of relevant details of your photos, you also have to consider the placement of the photo subject. **People or other important subjects of the photo must not be placed across the guide lines or beyond them towards the edge of the pagina.**



Put the whole subject outside the crop area towards the center of the page.
